-2% The American Community Survey (ACS) reported a -2% change in IEPZ Census Block Groups from 2015 to 2018.

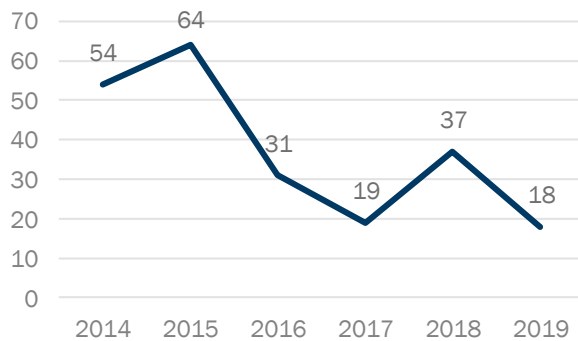
IEPZ RESIDENTS LIVING BELOW POVERTY

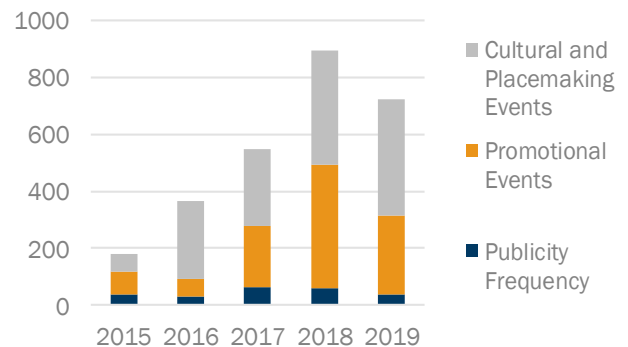

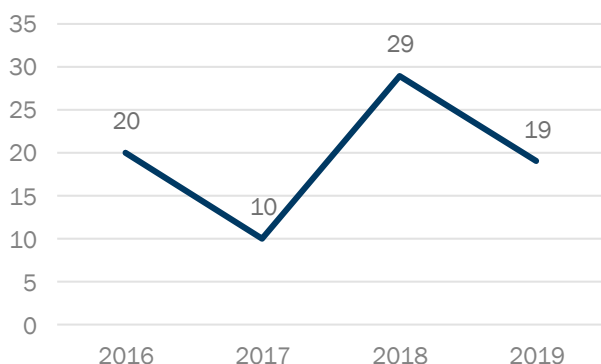

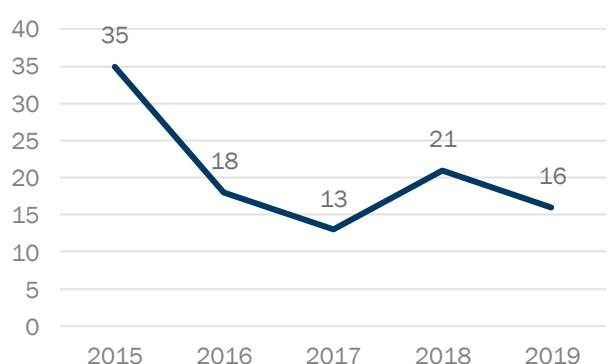
GREENSPACE IMPROVEMENTS, 2016-2019

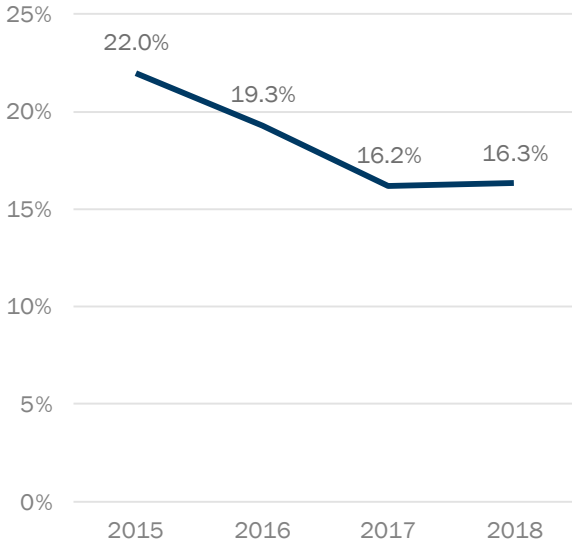

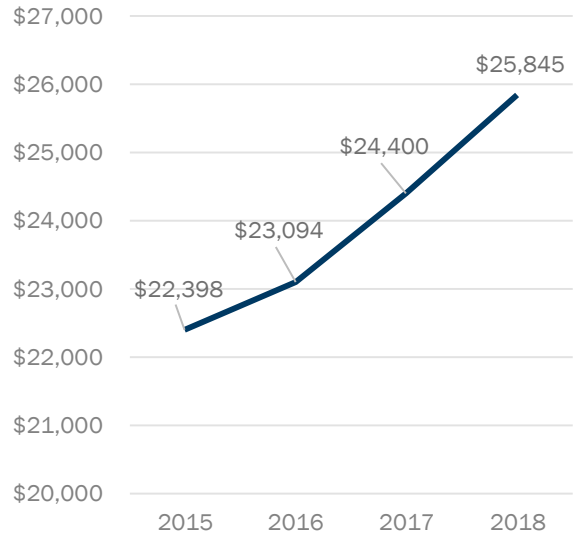
UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN PROMISE ZONE, 2015-2018

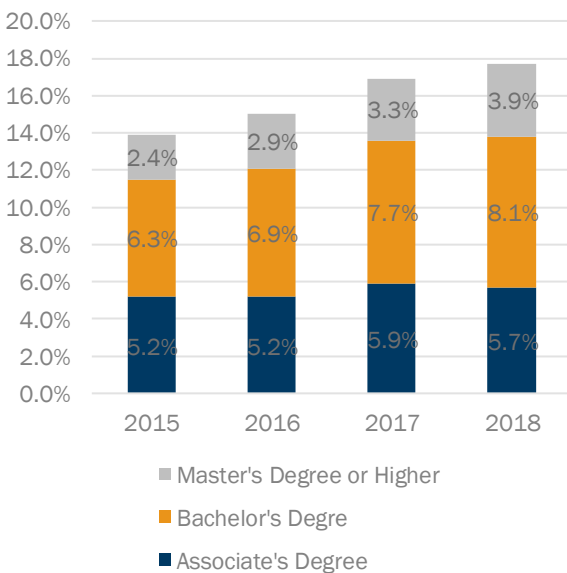
MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME IN PROMISE ZONE, 2015-2018

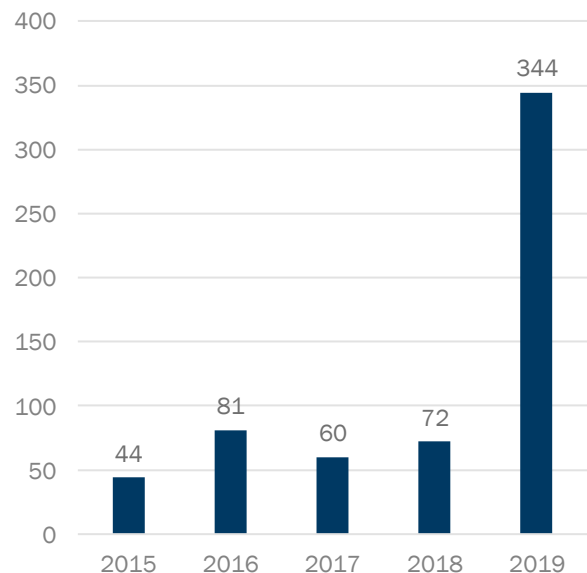
PERCENT OF RESIDENTS OVER 25 IN PROMISE ZONE WITH POST-SECONDARY DEGREES, 2015-2018

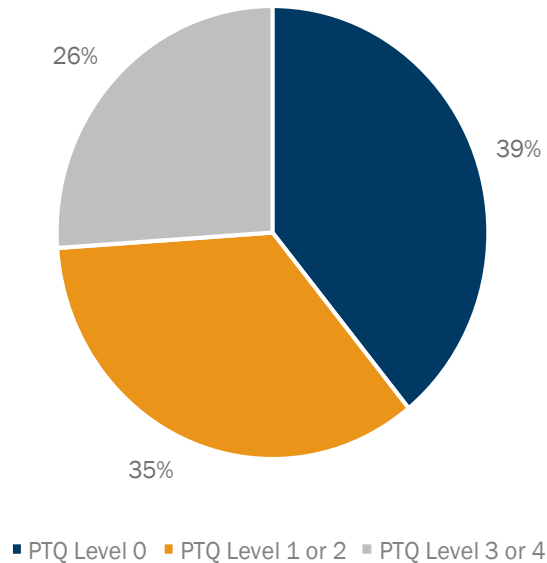

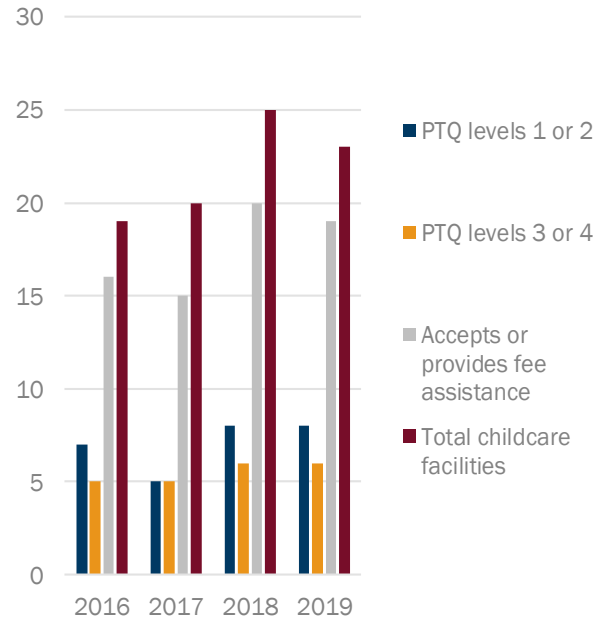

IEPZ CHILDCARE PROVIDERS BY PATHS TO QUALITY™ (PTQ) RANKINGS, 2019

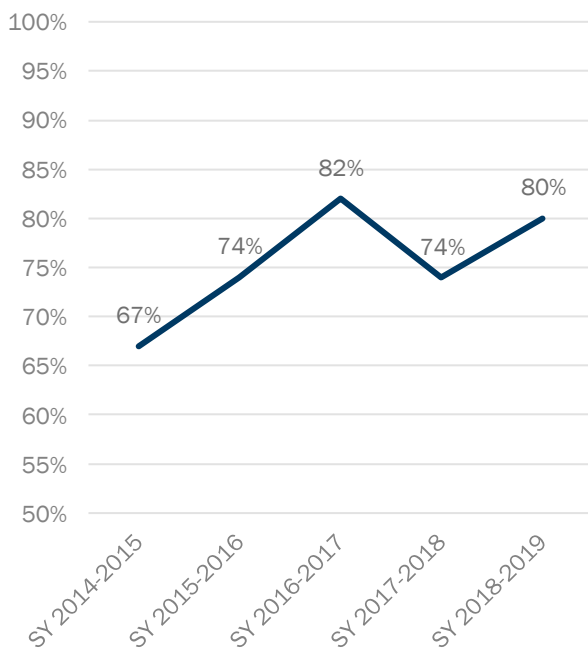

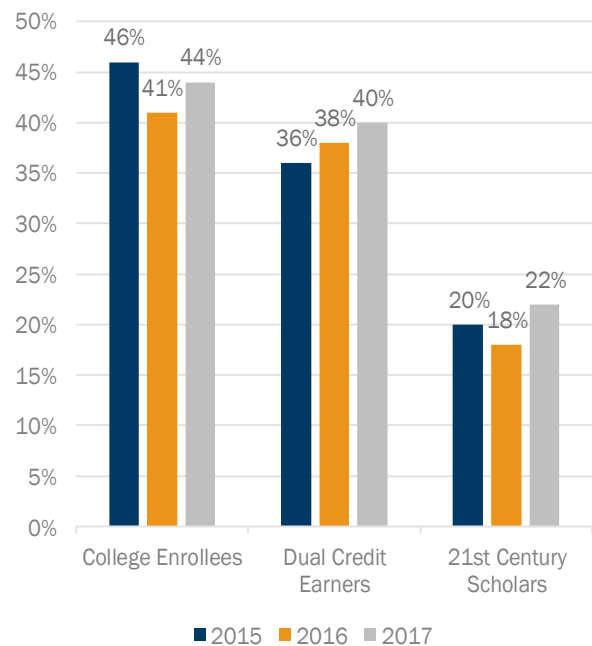

SELECTED CHARACTERISTICS OF ARSENAL TECH HIGH SCHOOL, 2015-2017

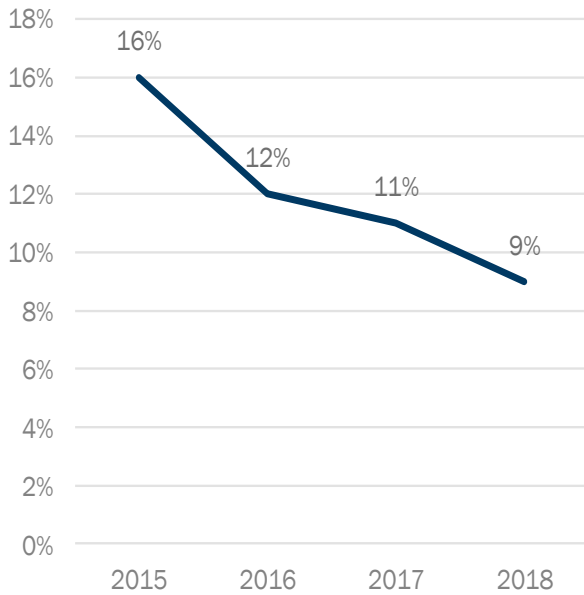

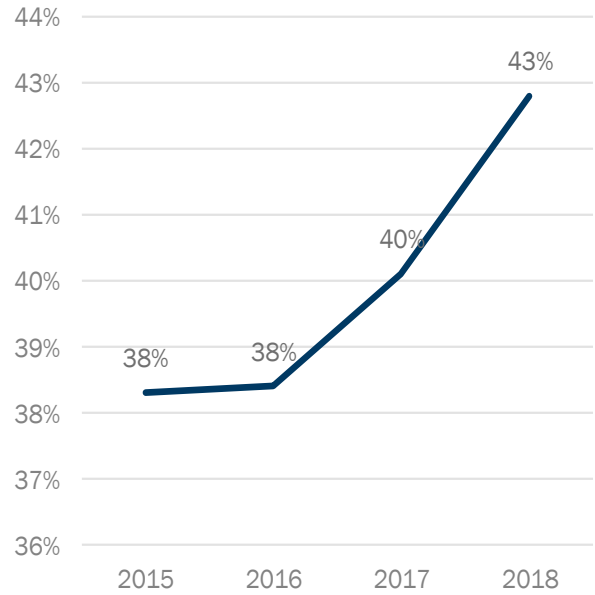

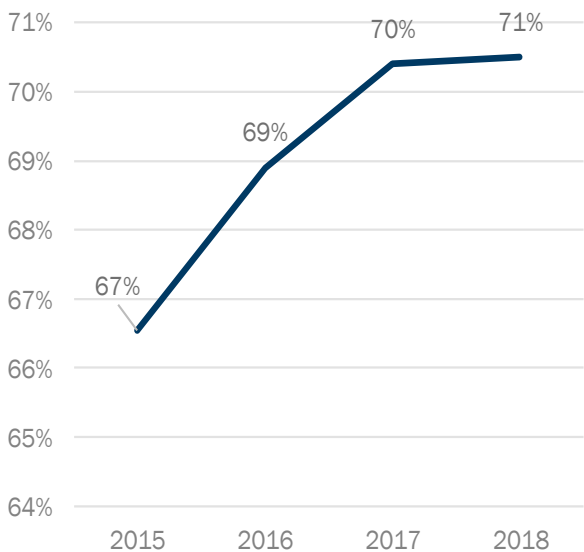
PERCENT OF OCCUPIED HOUSING UNITS OWNED IN PROMISE ZONE, 2015-2018

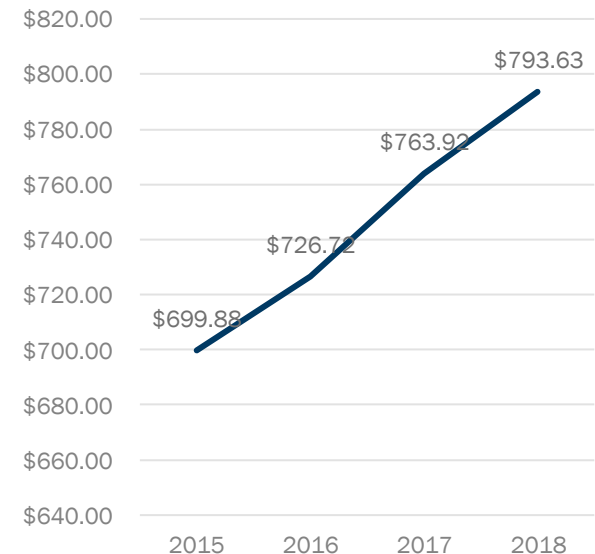
OCCUPANCY RATE OF PROPERTIES IN PROMISE ZONE, 2015-2018

MEDIAN GROSS RENT* AT PROPERTIES IN PROMISE ZONE, 2015 -2018

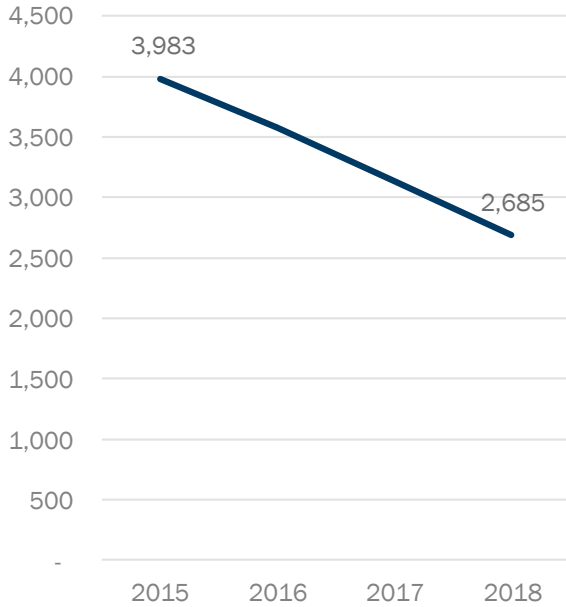

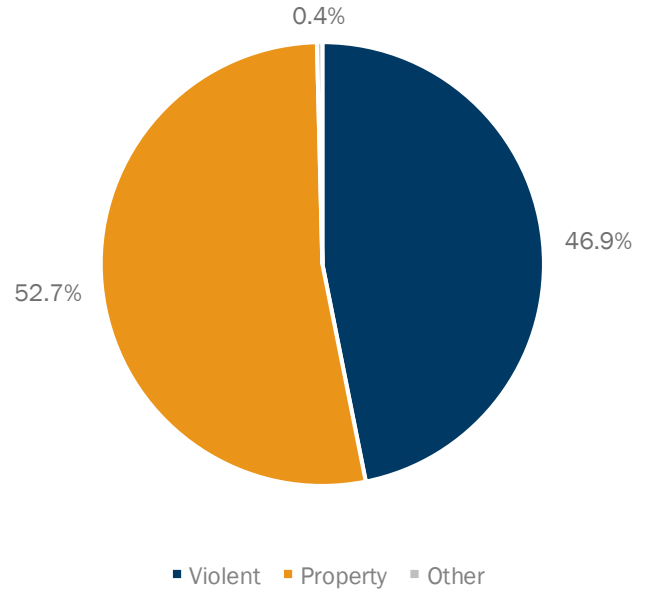

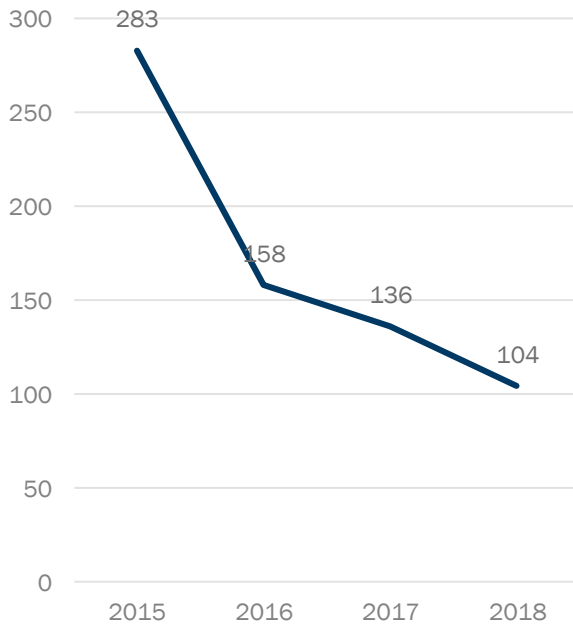
NUMBER OF CRIMES COMMITTED IN PROMISE ZONE BOUNDARIES, 2015–2018



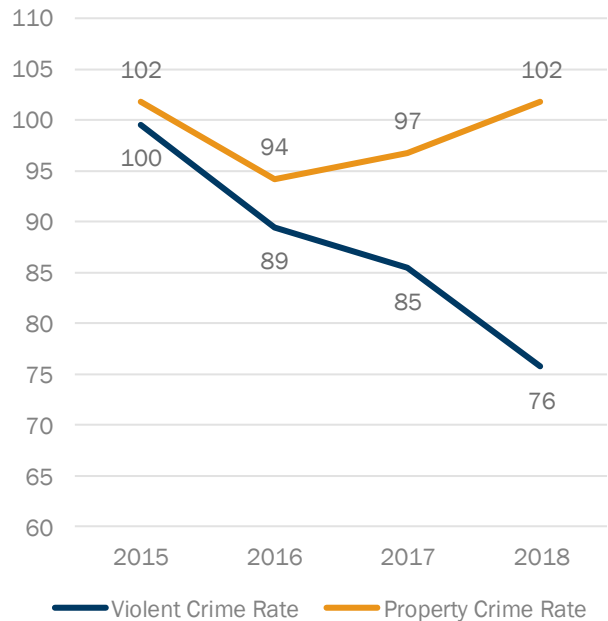
CRIMES COMMITTED IN PROMISE ZONE BOUNDARIES BY CLASSIFICATION OF OFFENSE, 2015-2018

VIOLENT AND PROPERTY CRIME RATE PER 1,000 POPULATION IN PROMISE ZONE BOUNDARIES, 2015-2018



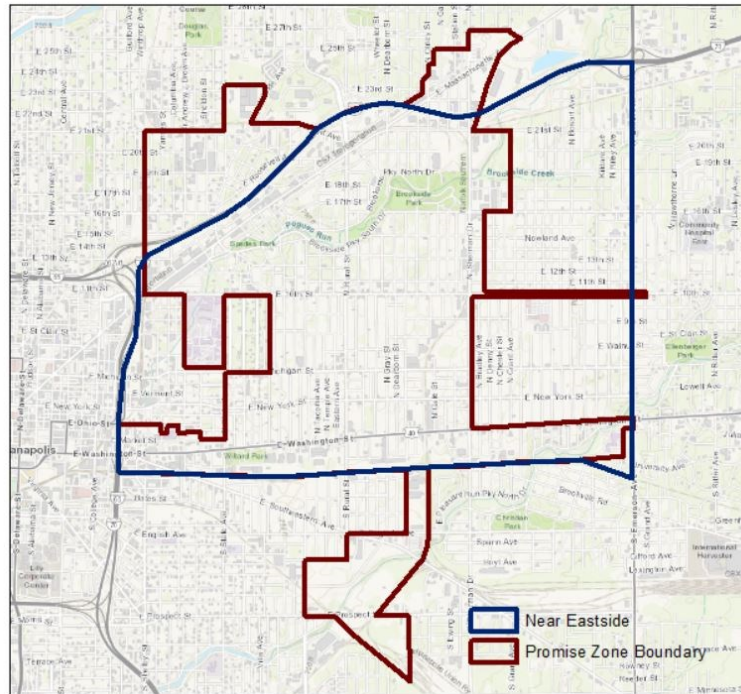

NEAR EASTSIDE QUALITY OF LIFE PLAN 2020

To prepare for the 2020 refreshing of the Near Eastside’s Quality of Life Plan, the Promise Zone assisted with surveying 1010 Near Eastside adult residents in 2019. The following results **reflect the perceptions of the 568 Promise Zone neighbors** on the status of the five Promise Zone goal areas: Buy, Live, Learn, Work, and Safe.

OVERLAPPING PROMISE ZONE AND NEAR EASTSIDE GEOGRAPHIES

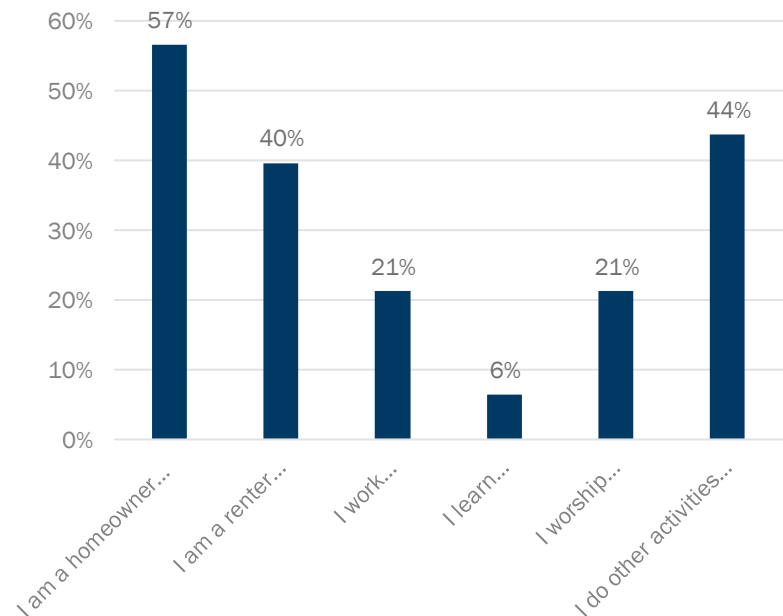

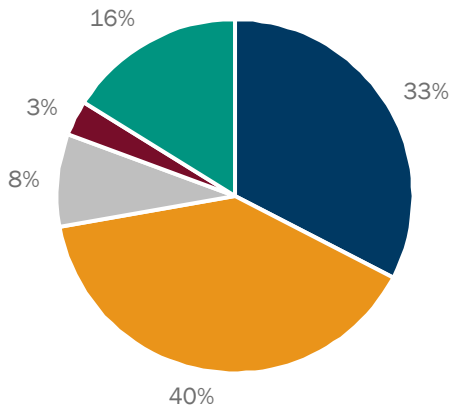

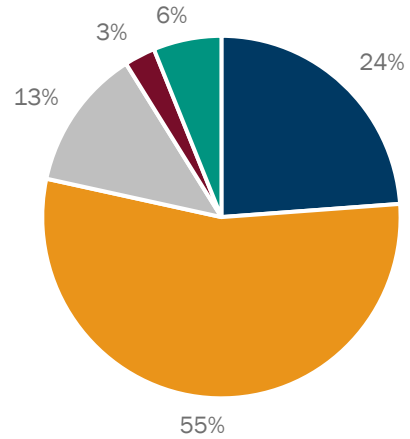

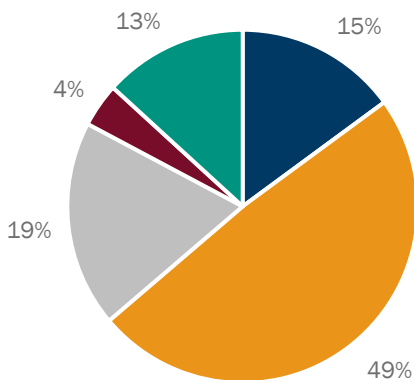

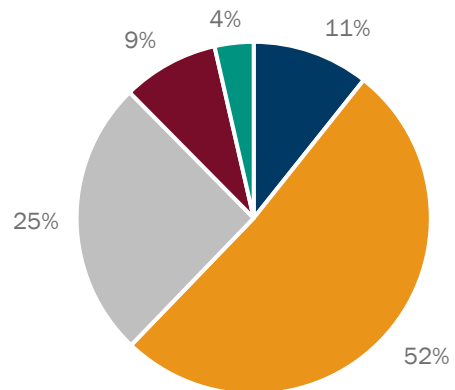

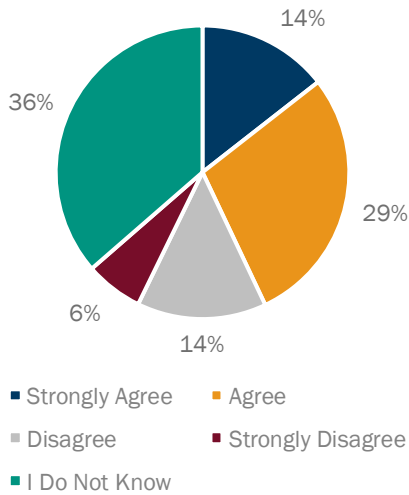

NEAR EASTSIDE QUALITY OF LIFE PLAN 2020

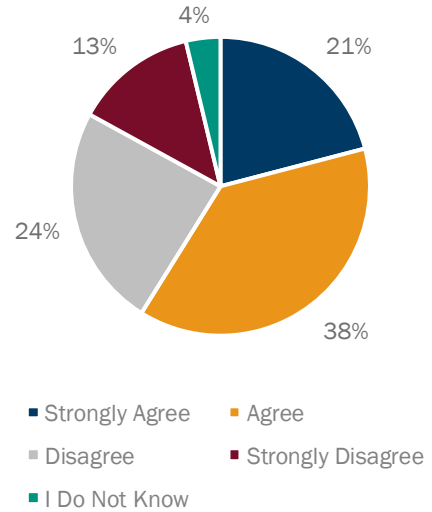
LEARN: CHILDREN HAVE ACCESS TO QUALITY PRESCHOOL OR EARLY LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES.

43% 4 out of 10 residents agree that children have access to quality preschool or early learning opportunities



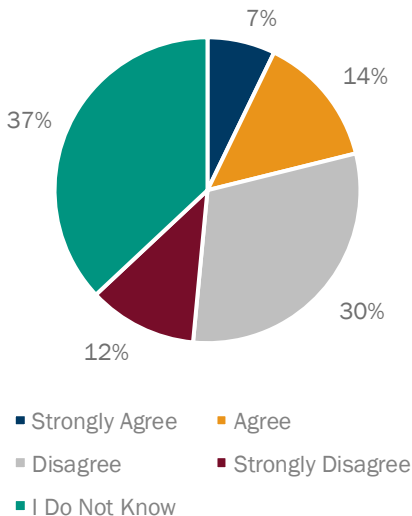
BUY: I CAN PURCHASE *AT LEAST HALF* OF MY GOODS AND SERVICES ON THE NEAR EASTSIDE.
